

Hale burns To 9:08.0

SACRAMENTO — Campolindo's sensational junior Tom Hale toured the two-mile in 9:08.0, the third fastest in history by an Eastbay prep, to capture the eight-lap event at the Sacramento Invitational here last night.

And another junior, Del Valle's Bob See, became the seventh fastest half-miler in Eastbay annals with a non-winning 1:53.9. Geoff Henderson of Washington in San Francisco edged See in 1:53.0.

In winning, Hale knocked 10.6 seconds off of his previous lifetime best, and set a meet record in the process. In addition, his clocking is the fastest timed by any prepster in the nation this year according to Track and Field News.

See managed to keep with the top runners in a torrid 53.5 first lap in the 880, and ended up in second, with a lifetime best by over two seconds.

In the high jump, Greg Redmond of Ygnacio Valley soared 6-5 to capture first place for the second consecutive year. Teammate Gary

Schneider placed fourth in the 180 low hurdles in 20.0, and took a fifth in the highs in 14.3.
